A Vision of Christ Rev 1:9-20

Rev 1:10 looking backward at the Gospel Age from the Second Advent perspective contrasted with 2Cor 12:2 where Paul is looking forward into the kingdom.

The seven angles mentioned in Rev Chapters 2 & 3 are the messengers to the 7 churches. Rev 2:1 Ephesus; 2:8 Smyrna; 2:12 Pergamum; 2:18 Thyatira; 3:1 Sardis; 3:7 Philadelphia; 3:14 Laodicea.

Angle Revelation chapter 17 through 22

Rv 17:1 Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls came and said to me (John), "Come, I (angel) will show you (John) the judgment of the great whore who is seated on many waters,

Rv 17:3 So he (angel) carried me (John) away in the spirit into a wilderness, and I (John) saw a woman sitting on a scarlet beast that was full of blasphemous names, and it had seven heads and ten horns.

Rv 17:6-8 6 And I (John) saw that the woman was drunk with the blood of the saints and the blood of the witnesses to Jesus. When I (John) saw her, I (John) was greatly amazed. 7 But the angel said to me, (John) "Why are you so amazed? I (angel) will tell you the mystery of the woman, and of the beast with seven heads and ten horns that carries her. 8 The beast that you (John) saw was, and is not, and is about to ascend from the bottomless pit and go to destruction. And the inhabitants of the earth, whose names have not been written in the book of life from the foundation of the world, will be amazed when they see the beast, because it was and is not and is to come.

Rv 17:15-18 15 And he (angel) said to me (John), "The waters that you saw, where the whore is seated, are peoples and multitudes and nations and languages. 16 And the ten horns that you (John) saw, they and the beast will hate the whore; they will make her desolate and naked; they will devour her flesh and burn her up with fire. 17 For God has put it into

their hearts to carry out his purpose by agreeing to give their kingdom to the beast, until the words of God will be fulfilled. 18 The woman you (John) saw is the great city that rules over the kings of the earth."

Rv 18:1-8 After this I saw another angel (Jesus) coming down from heaven, having great authority; and the earth was made bright with his splendor. 1 He called out with a mighty voice (angel), "Fallen, fallen is Babylon the great! ... 4 Then I (John) heard another voice from heaven saying, (angel) "Come out of her, my people, ...

Rv 19:1 After this I (John) heard what seemed to be the loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying,

Rv 19:5 And from the throne came a voice (Jesus & church) saying, ...

Rv 19:6 Then I (John) heard what seemed to be the voice of a great multitude, like the sound of many waters and like the sound of mighty thunderpeals, crying out,

Rv 19:9-10 9 And the angel said to me, (John) "Write this: Blessed are those (church & GC) who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb." And he said to me, "These are true words of God." 10 Then I (John) fell down at his (angel) feet to worship him, (angel) but he (angel) said to me, (John) "You must not do that! I (angel) am a fellow servant with you (John) and your comrades (GC) who hold the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."

Rv 19:11 Then I (John) saw heaven opened, and there was a white horse! Its rider is called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he judges and makes war.

Rv 19:17-21 17 Then I (John) saw an angel (angel) standing in the sun, and with a loud voice he called to all the birds that fly in midheaven, "Come, gather for the great supper of God, 18 to eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of the mighty, the flesh of horses and their riders – flesh of all, both free and slave, both small and great." 19 Then I (John) saw the beast and the kings of the earth with their armies gathered to make war against the rider on the horse and against his army.

Rv 20:1-3 1 Then I (John) saw an angel (Jesus) coming down from heaven, holding in his hand the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain. ...

Rv 20:4-6 4 Then I (John) saw thrones, and those seated on them were given authority to judge. I (John) also saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their testimony to Jesus and for the word of God. They had not worshiped the beast or its image and had not received its mark on their foreheads or their hands. They came to life and reigned with Christ a thousand years. 5 (The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were ended.) This is the first resurrection. 6 Blessed and holy are those (144,000) who share in the first resurrection. Over these the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ, and they will reign with him a thousand years.

Rv 20:11-15 11 Then I (John) saw a great white throne and the one who sat on it; the earth and the heaven fled from his presence, and no place was found for them. 12 And I (John) saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Also another book was opened, the book of life. And the dead were judged according to their works, as recorded in the books. ...

Rv 21:1-8 1 Then I (John) saw a new heaven and a new earth; for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more. 2 And I (John) saw the holy city, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. 3 And I (John) heard a loud voice from the throne saying, ... 5 And the one (Jesus) who was seated on the throne said, "See, I am making all things new." Also he said, "Write this, for these words are trustworthy and true." 6 Then he (Jesus) said to me, (John) "It is done! I (Jesus) am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end. To the thirsty I (Jesus) will give water as a gift from the spring of the water of life. 7 Those who conquer will inherit these things, and I (Jesus) will be their God and they will be my children. 8 But as for the cowardly, the faithless, the polluted, the murderers, the fornicators, the sorcerers, the idolaters, and all liars, their place will be in the lake that burns with fire and sulfur, which is the second death."

Rv 21:9-10 9 Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls full of the seven last plagues came and said to me, (John) "Come, I (angel) will show you (John) the bride, the wife of the Lamb." 10 And in the spirit he (angel) carried me (John) away to a great, high mountain and showed me (John) the holy city Jerusalem coming down out of heaven from God.

Rv 21:15 The angel (angel) who talked to me (John) had a measuring rod of gold to measure the city and its gates and walls.

Rv 21:17 He (angel) also measured its wall, one hundred forty-four cubits by human measurement, which the angel was using.

Rv 21:22 I (John) saw no temple in the city, for its temple is the Lord God the Almighty and the Lamb.

Rv 22:1 Then the angel showed me (John) the river of the water of life, bright as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb

Rv 22:6-7 6 And he (angel) said to me, (John) "These words are trustworthy and true, for the Lord, the God of the spirits of the prophets, has sent his angel to show his servants (John) what must soon take place." 7 "See, I (Jesus) am coming soon! Blessed is the one who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book."

Rv 22:8-13 8 I, John, am the one who heard and saw these things. And when I (John) heard and saw them, I (John) fell down to worship at the feet of the angel who showed them to me; (John) 9 but he (angel) said to me, (John) "You must not do that! I (angel) am a fellow servant with you (John) and your comrades (GC) the prophets, and with those who keep the words of this book. Worship God!" 10 And he (angel) said to me, (John) "Do not seal up the words of the prophecy of this book, for

the time is near. 11 Let the evildoer still do evil, and the filthy still be filthy, and the righteous still do right, and the holy still be holy." 12 "See, I (Jesus) am coming soon; my reward is with me, to repay according to everyone's work. 13 I (Jesus) am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end."

Rv 22:16 "It is I, Jesus, who sent my angel (angel) to you with this testimony for the churches. I am the root and the descendant of David, the bright morning star."

Rv 22:17-21 17 The Spirit (Jesus) and the bride (church) say, "Come. And let everyone who hears say, "Come." And let everyone who is thirsty come. Let anyone who wishes take the water of life as a gift. 18 I (Jesus) warn everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: if anyone adds to them, God will add to that person the plagues described in this book; 19 if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God will take away that person's share in the tree of life and in the holy city, which are described in this book. 20 The one who testifies to these things says, "Surely I (Jesus) am coming soon." Amen. Come, Lord Jesus! 21 The grace of the Lord Jesus be with all the saints. Amen.

Rv 1:1-3 1 The revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave him (Jesus) to show his servants (church) what must soon take place; he (Jesus) made it known by sending his (Jesus) angel to his servant John, (harvest church) 2 who testified to the word of God and to the testimony of Jesus Christ, even to all that he (John) saw. 3 Blessed is the one who reads aloud the words of the prophecy, and blessed are those who hear and who keep what is written in it; for the time is near.

Rotherham Rev 1:1 The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave to him, to point out unto his servants the things which must needs come to pass with speed,-and he shewed them by signs, sending through his messenger, unto his servant John;
